LIVE SHOWCASE & SALE QUALIFICATION:

- 1. Jr. Fair Members must qualify for the live showcase & sale. This is done by:
 - a. Exhibiting a Grand Champion or Reserve Grand Champion market animal.
 - b. Win Overall Senior or Junior Showman in their respective species.
 - i. Equine live sale qualifiers include the winners of Overall Senior and Junior Versatility. Senior Showmanship Sweepstakes Champion if this person is awarded Showmanship Sweepstakes Champion.
 - c. Be a bona fide final year member in a market animal species.
 - i. This means it must be an exhibitor's final year of eligibility, not simply the final year they are planning to participate.
 - ii. Final year members wishing to participate in the Livestock Showcase & Sale must participate in the service component of the sale program.

NO SERVICE=NO LIVE SALE.

- iii. Final year members must register through Fair Entry and provide necessary sale information to the sale committee by 6/30. No late entries accepted.
- d. Participate in the Dairy Products Basket or Dairy Goat Products Basket.

ONLINE PREMIUM SALE

- 1. All Jr. Fair market animal exhibitors who complete their projects, and exhibit at the fair are eligible for the online premium sale.
- 2. The online sale will begin no later than 8:00 am the Monday immediately following the fair and conclude no earlier than 5:00 pm the Friday immediately following the fair.
- 3. This is an add-on only premium sale in which any buyer can participate.
- 4. Buyers must register through the host site, Fair Entry, and can be accessed via the fair's website or by calling the Fair Office.

MARKET ANIMAL (NON CHAMPION) SALE OPTIONS

- 1. Sell (consign) to Sr. Fair Board for fair board determined market price.
- 2. Private treaty sale, available after animals are released from the fair.

3. All champion animals and those being consigned to the Fair Board will be loaded on trucks as trucks are available.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The Exhibitor is responsible for the care of his/her animal until it is released.
- 2. All sale animals will be identified by their ear tag or in the case of rabbits, tattoo.
- 3. All exhibitors in the market animal livestock sale (including online premium add-on auction) will be charged 2% of their gross check for administrative fees.
- 4. Only animals shown and judged at the Fair are eligible to be consigned for sale through the fairboard.
- 5. The sale order will be determined and managed by the Livestock Sale committee.
- 6. All Grand Champions and Reserve Champions will be sold in the live sale and will go to slaughter at a Fair Board designated slaughter facility.

Exceptions are beef feeders, dairy feeders, rabbits, and poultry.

- 7. Each Exhibitor is responsible for selling his/her own project. If unable to be present at sale time, exhibitor must designate another Jr. Fair member to sell that animal. Only those animals represented by the exhibitor or other designated person will be sold.
- 8. Exhibitors will receive notification when checks are available for pick up at the Fair Office. Advisors and Office staff may work together for group pickup.
- 9. All sale payments are due by August 28th, 2023. An interest charge will be accessed on the balance due starting August 28th, 2023 at the rate of 2% per month.
- 10. All feeder sale animals must be paid for before leaving the grounds. You must show paid invoice to dept. superintendent before loading any animal.
- 11. Pictures will be taken of all champion exhibits for publicity purpose; however, each newspaper reserves the right to decide which pictures are published.
- 12. All buyers will bid on an Exhibitor's premium indicated by a dollar amount, minimum starting bid of \$100.00. The buyer will strictly be providing a premium to the Exhibitor and not buying actual animals.
- 13. There will be no solicitation of bids inside the sale barn after the start of the sale.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS BY SPECIES

RABBIT SALE

1. All rabbits which are sold will be tattooed.

DAIRY PRODUCTS

1. Only Jr. Fair Dairy Exhibitors who are present at the sale (must sign in with Department Superintendent at sale ring) will share proceeds equally from the sale. Only 1 basket of Dairy Products will be auctioned.

DAIRY GOAT PRODUCTS

1. Only Jr. Fair Dairy/Breeding Goat Exhibitors who are present at the sale (must sign in with Department Superintendent at sale ring) will share proceeds equally from the sale. Only 1 basket of Dairy Goat Products will be auctioned.

SHEEP

1. The Ohio Sheep checkoff of ½ of 1% of the value of the sheep or lambs sold (market value X \$0.005) will be deducted from exhibitor's checks where sheep are sold through the Fair Board for market price. The Fair Board provides one remittance to the Ohio Sheep Improvement Association for all swine sold at the fair.

SWINE

1. The National Pork checkoff of \$0.0035 of gross market value per head sold will be deducted (GMV x \$0.0035) from exhibitor's checks where swine are sold through the fair board for market price. The Fair Board provides one remittance to the National Pork Board for all swine sold at the fair.

MARKET STEER/MARKET HEIFER/DAIRY STEERS

1. Cattle sold at the Fair will have \$2.00 per head deducted from final checks for beef checkoff. The Fair Board provides one remittance to the Ohio Beef Council for all cattle sold at the fair.

BEEF FEEDERS (Steers & Heifer Calves)

- 1. All feeders will be sold to determine market price Saturday, August 5th, 2023 starting at 9:00 am in the Pavilion show arena. Sale ring bids on Sunday will be premium only.
- 2. Cattle sold at the fair will have \$2.00 per head deducted from final checks for check off fees. The fair board provides one remittance to the Ohio Beef Council for all cattle sold at the fair.

DAIRY FEEDERS

- 1. All feeders will be sold to determine support price Saturday August 5th, 2023, starting at 9:00 am in the Pavilion show arena. Sale ring bids on Sunday will be premium only.
- 2. Cattle sold at the fair will have \$2.00 per head deducted from final checks for check off fees. The fair board provides one remittance to the Ohio Beef Council for all cattle sold at the fair.
- 3. Dairy Beef Feeders will be vaccinated at the May weigh in. Payment for the shot will be due to the veterinarian administering the shot at the time of vaccination.
