All exhibitors must have purchased a Wood County Fair membership or exhibitor pass at the time of registration, except children under 18 who may enter on a parent's membership or with a youth exhibitor pass.

Registration certificates and health certificates must be submitted at time animals are brought in and at any time on request of officials.

Produce of Dam–2 Animals from same cow either or both sexes, owned by exhibitor
