### GATE ADMISSIONS

Membership and Exhibitor tickets admit owner for daily admission to fairgrounds all week

On sale at Fair Office, Wood County Fairgrounds

**Lost Tickets Will Not Be Replaced – ALL SALES ARE FINAL, NO REFUNDS WILL BE OFFERED FOR ANY TICKET SALES**

Membership — \$30.00 — (residents of Wood County only), sold up to 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, August 2, 2026.  
after the deadline only Week Passes will be available.

Week Passes — \$30.00 — (non-county residents, exhibitors and post membership deadline for county residents),

Daily Gate Admission - \$8.00

Senior Day- Seniors 60+ will be admitted free with proper ID

Veterans Day - All Veterans and Active Duty Military will be admitted free with proper ID

**Week Passes cannot be exchanged for a voting membership.**

**Junior Fair - 4-H Wristbands will be available for advisor pick up, watch Facebook and 4-H communications for further details. FFA wristbands will be available for individual pick up in the office 3 days prior to the start of fair.**

A \$10.00 charge will be made to replace lost Junior Fair Wristbands

Admission Charges Start at 8:00 a.m. — Sunday, August 2nd

Children 9 and under are admitted free, without tickets. All other persons must have tickets to be admitted.

### ADMISSION GATES – ENTRANCES

**Gate A** – Haskins Road - Open for on Track Events and deliveries only

**Gate B and C** – on the north side of Poe Road (walk through only)

**Gate F** – by the Jr. Fair Building (walk through only)

All other walk through gates are for pass holders only.

### DELIVERY TRUCKS AND CARS

**All delivery cars or trucks must make deliveries before 10:00 a.m. daily and must enter and exit the grounds through Gate A.**

Commercial exhibitors, concession operators will be issued passes by the Office and will be directed as to how to enter the grounds.

No passes will be issued to livestock exhibitors. Vehicles must be in the north parking area after 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 midnight.

### SOLICITATIONS

Section 1711.12

**Red Book**

"No person shall be permitted to make solicitation of any nature on the Fairgrounds except in contracted concession or commercial rented spaces. No person will be permitted to post or display signs, distribute handbills or advertise material or sell or distribute free merchandise, except persons working within 4 feet of their contracted area."
