#### *Rules:*

- 1. All competitors must be a 4-H member currently enrolled in Wood County 4-H and must exhibit their 4-H project.*
- 2. Each Wood County Horse 4-H club is allowed to form only **one** team. In the event that a 4-H club does not have enough members to fill a team, they can fill their team by using members from another 4-H club.*
- 3. Each competitor & animal may exhibit in only one event.*
- 4. Each event will be judged in accordance with publication No. 179 – Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows.*
- 5. No exhibitor changes will be allowed after the 9:00 a.m. entry.*
- 6. All entries must appear in the Grand Entry as a team to be judged for overall appearance. Showmanship animals may appear in halter.*
- 7. Required attire is: Team T-shirt, Blue Jeans, Boots, Hat/Helmet.*
- 8. Use this form to make your team entry.*
- 9. Points earned in each class is as follows:*
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place receives 10 points through 1 point for 10<sup>th</sup> place regardless of the number of entries in the class.*
  - Total team points will declare tournament winners.*
  - In case of a tie, the team with the most 1<sup>st</sup> places, then 2<sup>nd</sup> places, etc. will be declared the winner.*

#### *Awards:*

*First place team will receive a trophy that they will hold for one year until the next team tournament competition. All teams will receive ribbons for their respective placing.*
