LIVESTOCK SHOWCASE SALE RULES

1. Jr. Fair Members must **qualify** to be entered into the Livestock Showcase Sale. You may qualify if you have accomplished any of the following:
 - a. Exhibited an Overall Grand or Reserve Grand Champion market animal.
 - i. Beef divisions need to have at least 5 animals shown in the division to allow the Grand and Reserve Champions for that division to go into the Showcase.
 - b. Won Supreme Sr. or Jr. Showman in their respective species.
 - d. Participated as the Equine Showmanship Sweepstakes Qualifier.
 - e. Winner of the Buchman Showmanship Sweepstakes.
2. Be a final year member of 4H or FFA.
 - a. These members must be a Senior in High School or have a bonus year to participate based on 4H/FFA age as of January 1 of the current fair year.
 - b. Exhibitors may only participate in the sale one time and must choose to do so either their Senior year or during their bonus year.
 - c. Final year members wishing to participate in the Livestock Showcase Sale must be physically present, check in **on time**, and participate in the service component of the sale program.
 - d. Final year members must register through Fair Entry by the June 1 deadline, as communicated by the Junior Fair office and Sale Committee. No late entries accepted.

ONLINE ADD ON SALE

1. All Jr. Fair Livestock and Equine exhibitors who complete and exhibit their project at the fair will be eligible for the Online Add On Sale
2. In order to participate in the Online, Add On Sale exhibitors must register in FairEntry by the June 1 deadline. **No Late entries will be accepted.**
3. The Online Sale will begin no later than 8:00 am the Monday immediately following the fair and conclude no earlier than 5:00 pm the Friday immediately following the fair.
4. This is an add-on only sale in which any buyer can participate.
5. Buyers must register through FairEntry and can be accessed via the fair's website or by calling the Fair Office.

GENERAL RULES

1. All exhibitors selling their market animal(s) to the Sr. Fairboard (via the market truck), participating in the Online Add On Sale or participating in the Livestock Showcase Sale will be charged 2% commission for administrative fees.
2. Only animals shown and judged at the fair are eligible to be sold to the Sr. Fairboard (via the market truck).

3. The Livestock Showcase Sale order will be determined and managed by the Livestock Sale committee.
4. All Grand and Reserve Champion Market Animals will be sold and go to slaughter at a Fair Board designated slaughter facility. Market price will be paid for these animals. Exceptions are beef feeders, dairy feeders, dairy crossbred feeders, rabbits, and poultry.
5. Exhibitors will receive notification about when checks will be available for pick up at the Fair Office and a pick-up date will be set. Checks will be mailed 14 days following the posted pick-up date.
6. All sale payments must be received in the fair office by August 31, 2026. Any invoices not paid by August 31, 2026 will have their credit card on file charged. Credit card processing fees are the responsibility of the card holder.
7. All feeder calves must be paid for prior to leaving the grounds. You must show a paid invoice to the Dept. Superintendent or approved Committee Member before loading any animal.
8. Pictures will be taken of all champion exhibits for publicity purposes. Date and time will be announced during each show.
9. The state mandated species (beef, pork, sheep) check off fees will be assessed and deducted from exhibitor market checks.

SPECIAL SALE CONSIDERATIONS BY SPECIES

SHEEP- The Ohio Sheep checkoff of $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% of the value of the sheep or lambs sold (market value X \$0.005) will be deducted from exhibitor's checks where sheep are sold through the Fair Board for market price. The Fair Board provides one remittance to the Ohio Sheep Improvement Association for all swine sold at the fair.

SWINE- The National Pork checkoff of \$0.0035 of gross market value per head sold will be deducted (GMV x \$0.0035) from exhibitor's checks where swine are sold through the fair board for market price. The Fair Board provides one remittance to the National Pork Board for all swine sold at the fair.

BEEF- Cattle sold at the Fair will have \$2.00 per head deducted from final checks for beef checkoff. (This includes all feeders sold) The Fair Board provides one remittance to the Ohio Beef Council for all cattle sold at the fair.

BEEF FEEDERS/DAIRY FEEDERS /DAIRY CROSS FEEDERS- All feeders will be sold to determine market price Saturday, August 8, 2026, beginning at 9:00 am in the Pavilion show arena.

Sale ring bids on Sunday will be premium only.
