Rules:

1. All entries must be made in advance — Please see Page 4 of Fair Book for “Everything You Need To Know To Enter 2022 Fair” **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED— Only one entry per exhibitor in each classification.**

2. Articles will be judged in the class in which they are entered, and none will be reclassified. If not sure of classification, please check with the Director- In-Charge before entering article.

3. No kits.

4. All exhibits must be taken to Fine Arts Building at the Fairgrounds on the Saturday immediately prior to the fair from Noon-3:00 P.M.

5. Exhibits must be claimed the Tuesday after the last day of the fair from 5:00-7:00 P.M.

6. Articles in Crafts Department must have been made by exhibitor.

7. On the back of exhibitor ticket print your name clearly with a marker. After judging ticket will be turned over for fairgoer viewing.

8. We do not guarantee the safety of exhibits, but precautions will be taken to protect exhibits.

9. Any item that does not comply with rules will be marked “Display Only” and not eligible for premiums.

2. All exhibits must be taken to Fine Arts Building at the Fairgrounds on the Saturday immediately prior to the fair from Noon-3:00 P.M.

3. Exhibits must be claimed the Tuesday after the last day of the fair from 5:00-7:00 P.M.

4. All collections must fit on 11”x15” area. Collections exceeding this size will be disqualified.

5. Collection must have been collected by exhibitor. Any item that does not comply with rules will be marked “Display Only” and not eligible for premiums.

6. Items can only be exhibited two years. Label specimens.

7. Exhibitors encouraged to record on a card any information of interest to the public concerning their display.

8. **On back of exhibitor ticket print your name clearly with a marker. After judging ticket will be turned over for fairgoer viewing.**
