### **PREMIUM CHECKS (except Livestock Sale) issued for the 2022**

**Fair must be picked up at the Fair Entry Office during the same hours of picking up your entries on August 8th & 9th. Premium checks must be picked up at the Entry Office as NO CHECKS WILL BE MAILED.**

**To make entries please use the fair entry program at [www.woodcounty-fair.com](http://www.woodcounty-fair.com) or mail entries to: Wood County Agricultural Society, P.O. Box 146, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402. If mailing, please send stamped, self-addressed envelope for return of pass and entry confirmation. Entries close July 16th.**

Exhibitors must purchase membership or exhibitor tickets, at \$26.00, at time of entry. If entrant is under 18 they may enter under a parent's exhibitor pass or may purchase a youth exhibitor pass for \$3.50.

Exhibitors are responsible for entries in proper classes.

Classes to be as follows within each classification:

Class I — C (cock) male bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class II — H (hen) female bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class III — CL (cockerel) male bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

Class IV — P (pullet) female bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

Each bird requires an entry.

**Limit two entries per class, per exhibitor.**

Right reserved to refuse entries when coops are filled.

Exhibits must be in place 8:00 a.m., Mon., August 1st and until 5:00 p.m. Mon., August 8<sup>th</sup>.

Any specimen showing symptoms of disease will be refused or taken from exhibit and held isolated, if possible.

"Each poultry exhibitor must comply with one of the following (does not include waterfowl):

1. Poultry exhibited were obtained from a flock or hatchery of origin which is a participant in the National Poultry Improvement Plan for the eradication of disease, (all commercial Ohio hatcheries meet this requirement), or,
2. Poultry are from a flock which has had a negative test for Pullorum disease within 12 months, or,
3. Poultry have had a negative test for Pullorum disease within 90 days, or,
4. Exhibited poultry tested negative for Pullorum disease by a State approved tester.
5. **NO POULTRY EXHIBITS ALLOWED IN BARN UNTIL NPIP PAPERS CHECKED BY POULTRY COMMITTEE.**
6. **OUT OF STATE POULTRY MUST HAVE NPIP FORM 9-3 ALONG WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM WHEN ENTRIES ARE MADE OR BIRDS WILL NOT SHOW AT THE 2020 WOOD COUNTY FAIR. POULTRY TESTER MAY BE AVAILABLE ON THE FAIRGROUNDS. A copy of the NPIP form will be kept on file at the Wood County Fair Office.**
7. **Indicate on entry form if bird(s) are also entered under 4-H or FFA for pen assignment.**

Under health regulations check Rule 901:1-18-05 and read the entire health notice.

Health requirements are found starting on page 12 at the front of the fair book.

All exhibits entered at the owner's risk.

Owners must furnish feed and make provisions for care of exhibits which include non spillable water containers and dry bedding. Pens must be cleaned out at the end of fair.

Coops will be furnished. ENTRIES CLOSED WHEN PEN SPACE FILLED.

Show will be classified.

**Judging starts Thurs., Aug. 4th @ noon or after Jr. Show.**

American Standard of Perfection and comparison method of judging.

Need not to be present for judging. Judging will take place at the cage where birds are displayed.
