RULES

1. The contest is open to the Senior Showmanship winner in each of the following nine livestock departments: beef, swine, sheep, dairy, horses, market goats, dairy goats, rabbits & poultry.
2. The contest is divided into nine parts (one for each livestock department) with a different judge for each of the nine livestock departments represented.
3. In case someone wins 1st place showmanship in two or more departments, the department for each winner is determined by a coin toss.
4. Each member will show eight different species of animals. Members will not show the animal in the department they are representing. Members are expected to use the correct showmanship technique for all species shown.
5. The animals used in the contest will be selected by the Junior Fair Superintendent in charge of that particular department. Exhibitors cannot show their own animal. There will be a random draw to see who shows what animal.
6. Each judge will rate the participants on a scale of one to eight with one being the best. Member with the fewest total points in the nine departments will be the winner.
7. In case of a tie, hogs will be used as tiebreaker and then move backward through the list.
8. Showmanship Sweepstakes first place winners may not compete again, but non-winning participants may.
9. Order for showing: Horses, Beef, Market Goats, Dairy Goats, Dairy Cattle, Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep and Hogs.
