NORTH WEST OHIO HOT FARM CLASS RULES

- 1.) Classes: 7,500 lbs., 8,500 lbs., 9,500 lbs. and 10,500 lbs.
- 2.) Tires: Maximum 24.5 X 32 – any cut.
- 3.) Age of Driver: 16 years or older.
- 4.) Fuel: Diesel fuel only; water injection ok, no combustible fuels in water.
- 5.) Cylinder Block or Crank Case: Must be agriculture type and must bolt in stock location. All 6 cylinder engines are limited to 540 cubic inches or smaller. All V8 engines must be 640 cubic inches or smaller. All engine upgrades must be approved by the committee.
- 6.) Heads: Cast iron heads only. Must be from same manufacturer. No overhead cams allowed.
- 7.) Turbo, One Only, Manifolds: One single stage turbo allowed. Maximum 3.15 compressor wheel. The wheel may be no larger than this measurement at the inlet. Tips of wheel must protrude into opening at least ¼". All air must enter the compressor housing inlet. No external altering of compressor housings. Any size exhaust outlet and housing. Turbo must not extend through hood. Manifolds must be from same manufacturer and must bolt onto head without modification, alteration for turbo mounting allowed. Combine manifolds ok. No intercoolers.
- 8.) RPM's: 3000 RPM limit under no load.
- 9.) 15 MPH limit.
- 10.) Drawbar: Drawbars must not exceed 20 inches in height or less than 18 inches from

the center of axle to hooking point. No part of drawbar may extend rearward beyond point of hook. Drawbars must be stationary in all directions. No clevis.

- 11). Hood, Grill, Frame, Transmission, Rear End, Axle: Must be for that make and model and must maintain stock appearance. Front ends may be homemade with a maximum of 114" wheelbase. Frames may be homemade but must maintain stock appearance. Upgrades on sheet metal must be approved by the committee.
- 12). Total Length of Tractor: Maximum length 13' from center of rear axle to the furthest point forward, including weights.
- 13). Safety equipment must have the following: Scatter Blanket, Wheelie Bars, Kill Switches, Fire Extinguishers, Fenders, Side Shields.
- 14). No Steel Fans.
- 15). Must have wide front end.
- 16). SFI Clutch recommended but not required. Ladder bars are recommended but not required.
- 17). Any tractor with a roll cage or ROPS must wear seatbelt and helmet.

General Rules by Wood County Agricultural Society

1. Every participant and spectator enters the infield at their own risk. The Wood County Agricultural Society and its agents will not be held responsible for any injuries or property damage.
2. All participants, upon entry, release The Wood County Agricultural Society and its agents from all liability. Participants recognize that they will be held responsible for any injuries or damages occurring from the operation of their vehicle while on the fairgrounds.
3. All persons entering the fairgrounds will pay gate admission.
4. The contest will be governed by the Tractor and Truck Pull Committee of The Wood County Agricultural Society. If a participant wishes to file a protest against any pull there will be a \$500.00 protest fee payable upon submission of the protest. If the protest is lost the \$500.00 fee will be forfeited to The Wood County Agricultural Society. The Pull Committee's decision will be final.
5. Any participant found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted to pull, or will be disqualified.
6. All vehicles will be operated in a safe manner while on the fairgrounds. Anyone operating in a dangerous manner will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
7. **Everyone participating will pay for fair admission and pit passes.**
8. The sled operator or the pull committee have the right to refuse to hook any vehicle they feel is not safe or fit to pull.
9. Violation of any rule can be grounds for disqualification.
10. Each vehicle will only be entered once per class.
11. All classes will have a floating finish line.

12. Entries will close one class prior to the first hook of that class.
13. Each participant will hook in the order of draw or where placed by the pull committee.
Any delays in hooking to the sled, or starting once hooked to the sled can be grounds for disqualification.
14. All vehicles will weigh out after each pull (with the driver) and have its hitch height checked. Anyone failing to comply with this will be disqualified. If there are any questions at the scales the vehicle will remain at the scales until a member of the pull committee arrives, or they will be disqualified.
15. All contestants will be 16 years old or older. Minors will need a release signed by a parent or legal guardian.
16. All drivers must be able to reach and operate all controls of the vehicle while sitting in the driver's seat.
17. The first pull of the day, on each track, will be the only test hook.
18. No additional riders in any vehicle while on pulling track.
19. No entries will be refunded after the start of the class.
