Competition Open to all Ohio Counties

Entry fee: \$2.00 per bird

Entries in Place: Saturday, August 1st, 2:00 pm. Coops will be furnished. Entries will be cut off when Coop space is filled, if prior to the end of the open class entry period.

Judging: Wednesday, August 5th, Noon or after the Jr. Fair Show

Entry Release: Sunday, August 9th, 9:00 pm. Exhibits removed prior to that time forfeit all premiums and awards. Premiums may be picked up on Monday August 10th at the Fair Office.

Entry Limit: Two entries per person, per classification. Each bird requires an entry.

All exhibitors must have purchased a Wood County Fair membership or Week pass at the time of registration, except children under 18 who may enter on a parent's membership or with a youth exhibitor pass.

NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED

Exhibitors are responsible for entries in proper classes.

Classes to be as follows within each classification:

Class I — C (cock) male bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class II — H (hen) female bird hatched prior to Jan. 1 of this year.

Class III — CL (cockerel) male bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

Class IV — P (pullet) female bird hatched after Jan. 1 of this year.

Any specimen showing symptoms of disease will be refused or taken from exhibit and held isolated, if possible.

"Each poultry exhibitor must comply with one of the following (does not include waterfowl):

1. Poultry exhibited were obtained from a flock or hatchery of origin which is a participant in the National Poultry Improvement Plan for the eradication of disease, (all commercial Ohio hatcheries meet this requirement), or,
2. Poultry are from a flock which has had a negative test for Pullorum disease within 12 months, or,
3. Poultry have had a negative test for Pullorum disease within 90 days, or,
4. Exhibited poultry tested negative for Pullorum disease by a State approved tester.
5. **NO POULTRY EXHIBITS ALLOWED IN BARN UNTIL NPIP PAPERS CHECKED BY POULTRY COMMITTEE.**
6. **OUT OF STATE POULTRY MUST HAVE NPIP FORM 9-3 ALONG WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM WHEN ENTRIES ARE MADE OR BIRDS WILL NOT SHOW AT THE WOOD COUNTY FAIR. POULTRY TESTER MAY BE AVAILABLE ON THE FAIRGROUNDS. Turkeys cannot be tested on the fairgrounds. A copy of the NPIP form will be kept on file at the Wood County Fair Office.**
7. Indicate on entry form if bird(s) are also entered under 4-H or FFA for pen assignment.

Under health regulations check Rule 901:1-18-05 and read the entire health notice.

Health requirements are found starting on page 65 in the fair book.

All exhibits entered at the owner's risk.

Entry tags must be securely attached to the cage. Owners must furnish feed and make provisions for care of exhibits which include non-spillable water containers and dry bedding. Pens must be cleaned out at the end of fair. **Exhibitors must "sign out" with barn official after final cleaning or risk being banned from exhibiting the following year. Do NOT fold cages! ODA requires all birds to be ID'd. Leg bands will be attached during check-in.**

Show will be classified according to the American Standard of Perfection and comparison method of judging.

Need not to be present for judging. Judging will take place at the cage where birds are displayed.
